# Health and Career Education (CLE) 7 Course Outline/Scope and Sequence

Introduction to Career Education:	A person's career is considered their "journey" through life, and the Career Education curriculum offers students the opportunity to pursue this journey in personally meaningful and goal-oriented ways. Career-life development with intent is the ongoing process of self-discovery, growth in competence, and learning from experiences in educational, work-related, and personal life contexts.  The Career Education curriculum supports students in becoming successful, educated citizens by helping them learn how to effectively manage their life journey toward preferred future possibilities. This area of learning requires students to identify and develop their personal interests, passions, and competencies. Students reflect on learning experiences in school and community, build confidence through their contributions, and explore multiple career-life roles and choices. The curriculum fosters lifelong learning, beginning in kindergarten and continuing through to graduation and beyond.

#### Let's Get Started

- 1. Students visit www.myBlueprint.ca/sd83, and click on SCHOOL Account Log In

- 3. Select Who Am I from the navigation menu on the left-hand side of your screen. Then select the tab Surveys.
- 4. Complete ONLY the Learning Styles survey to receive your results
- 5. Review the Study Tips for your Learning Style (s) and try one out this month!
- 6. Add your Learning Style to your About Me Portfolio
- 7. Write a brief reflection (Did you learn something new about yourself? Do you agree or disagree? Why or why not?)

- 1. Select Home from the navigation menu on the left-hand side of your screen. Then select the tab Goals.
- 2. Add ONE (1) Academic Goal (short term, term 1) and include an Action Plan for how you intend to achieve it. This can be around learning a new skill or to improve on a specific subject area.
- 3. Add this academic goal to your About Me Portfolio.
- 4. Add ONE (1) Other Goal (short term) and include an Action Plan for how you intend to achieve it. This can be about anything else in your life that you would like to improve on.
- 5. Add this goal to your About Me Portfolio.

- 3. If you have achieved your term 1 goal, please add a new Academic Goal (one, short term, term 2) and include an Action Plan for how you intend to achieve it. What do you want to learn more about? Is there a program that interested you? Was there anything that surprised you?

#### **FEBRUARY**

#### **ACTIVITY #1: Reflection of Core Competencies #2**

- 1. Select Home from the navigation menu on the left-hand side of your screen. Then select the tab Portfolios.
- 2. Open your Grade 7 portfolio.
- 3. "Add" a box
- 4. Title this box Core Competency Term 2, your Description should read: Self Reflection, then choose "Add Media"
- **5.** Take a picture of your Core Competency Reflection Sheet, which you will complete with your classroom teacher, upload it!

#### **ACTIVITY #2: Resumes**

- 1. Select Work from the navigation menu on your dashboard, click on Resumes.
- 2. Review the **Resume Guide** to learn more about effective resume building. Select **Back to Resume** in the top right corner of your screen to return to building your resume.
- 3. Create a resume. Add your Contact information; fill in the Objective (what is the purpose of your resume, be clear so the employer knows what you are looking for), Education, Skills and Abilities (the employer wants to know what you can do) and Volunteer Experience, and any other sections you feel you need. When you print your resume, it will only print what you have populated.
- 4. You can "switch" the order of appearance of your sections....your objective should be first, followed by work education, work experience, skills, certificates, hobbies. **References** belong at the end and needs to complete do NOT insert "available upon request"

**HOMEWORK:** Print a copy of your resume and hand it in to your classroom teacher. Be sure the resume you hand in is one that is truly useable. Be sure you proofread! This should be a document you use to look for a summer job.



#### MARCH

#### **ACTIVITY #1: Occupations**

- 1. Select Favourites from the navigation menu on the left-hand side of your screen.
- 2. Find the 3 Occupations that you saved in December. Choose two occupations that you would like to compare.
- **3.** Compare them by clicking the menu on the right-hand side of the occupation you would like to compare. A drop-down menu will appear. Select compare. Repeat this process for the other occupation you would like to compare.

NOTE: At the top of your page, your compared items will appear. Select the blue compare button to view a side-by-side comparison of your selections.

- 4. Consider and compare the following:
  - a. Job title
  - **b.** What do they do
  - c. Education needed
  - d. Outlook
  - e. Salary range
  - f. What is the job environment like
  - g. Skills needed
  - h. High school courses you could take that might help you or are required
  - i. What you like/dislike about this job
- Add your top 3 occupations to your About Me Portfolio and use the reflection box to compare (Pros vs Cons)

**HOMEWORK:** Complete the Occupation Assignment sheet attached and hand it in to your classroom teacher with your name on it.
