| Introduction to Career Education: | A person's career is considered their "journey" through life, and the Career Education curriculum offers students the opportunity to pursue this journey in personally meaningful and goal-oriented ways. Career-life development with intent is the ongoing process of self-discovery, growth in competence, and learning from experiences in educational, work-related, and personal life contexts. The Career Education curriculum supports students in becoming successful, educated citizens by helping them learn how to effectively manage their life journey toward preferred future possibilities. This area of learning requires students to identify and develop their personal interests, passions, and competencies. Students reflect on learning experiences in school and community, build confidence through their contributions, and explore multiple career-life roles and choices. Let's Get Started

- 1. Students visit www.myBlueprint.ca/sd83, and click on SCHOOL Account Log In
 - Enter your SD 83 log in credentials and click Sign In.

ACTIVITY: Personality Survey

- 1. Select Portfolios from the tab menu in the home section.
- 2. Add a new portfolio (+ Add Portfolio) titled 'About Me Portfolio grade 8'. This portfolio will allow you to showcase your interests, passions, goals, and career interests.
- 3. Select Who Am I from the navigation menu on the left-hand side of your screen. Then select the tab Surveys.
- 4. Complete ONLY the Personality Styles survey to receive your results
- 5. Add your Personality Style to your About Me Portfolio
- **6.** Write a brief **reflection** (Did you learn something new about yourself? Do you agree or disagree? Why or why not?)

ACTIVITY #2: Goal Setting for Term 1

- 1. Select Home from the navigation menu on the left-hand side of your screen. Then select the tab Goals.
- 2. Add ONE (1) Academic Goal (short term, term 1) and include an Action Plan for how you intend to achieve it. This can be around learning a new skill or to improve on a specific subject area.
- 3. Add this academic goal to your About Me Portfolio.
- 4. Add ONE (1) Other Goal (short term) and include an Action Plan for how you intend to achieve it. This can be about anything else in your life that you would like to improve on.
- 5. Add this goal to your About Me Portfolio.

Note: You will write a brief reflection about your goal achievement progress at the end of term.

ACTIVITY #2: Resumes

- 1. Select Work from the navigation menu on your dashboard, click on Resumes.
- 2. Review the **Resume Guide** to learn more about effective resume building. Select **Back to Resume** in the top right corner of your screen to return to building your resume.
- 3. Create a new resume or add to your resume from grade 7. If you haven't already, update or add your Contact information; fill in the Objective (what is the purpose of your resume, be clear so the employer knows what you are looking for), Education, Skills and Abilities (the employer wants to know what you can do) and Volunteer Experience, and any other sections you feel you need. When you print your resume, it will only print what you have populated.
- 4. You can "switch" the order of appearance of your sections....your objective should be first, followed by work education, work experience, skills, certificates, hobbies. **References** belong at the end and needs to complete do NOT insert "available upon request"

HOMEWORK: Print a copy of your resume and hand it in to your classroom teacher. Be sure the resume you hand in is one that is truly useable. Be sure you proofread! This should be a document you use to look for a summer job.



MARCH

- 1. From the left-hand navigation menu select post-Secondary. Then select College and University.
- 2. Your job is to investigate 1 **college program** that interests you. Use the "search" bar to investigate and the "filters" to narrow your search. Click on the three grey dots on the top right-hand corner of your selection to add it to your grade 8 portfolio. **Then, click on the heart so that you "favourite" this program.**
- 3. Your job is to investigate 1 university program that interests you. Use the "search" bar to investigate and the "filters" to narrow your search. You can choose your "category", but the province must be British Columbia, and the "pathway" must be university. Click on the three grey dots on the top right-hand corner of your selection to add it to your grade 8 portfolio. Then, click on the heart so that you "favourite" this program.
- 4. Complete the Post Secondary Program assignment sheet attached. Complete by clicking on your "favourites" in the navigation menu and looking into the programs you selected, under "programs".
- 5. Hand in the completed worksheet to your classroom teacher.
